First Lesson: Acts 5:27-32 -

Temple Priests bring disciples before them

Ordering them not to speak any more

Peter and the disciples say the must obey God.

Epistle: Revelation 1:4-8

He is coming and every eye will see

The Alpha the Omega

The one who is and was and who is to come

The Almighty

Gospel: John 20:19-31

Easter Night, Christ appears to the disciples

If you forgive, they are forgiven, etc.

And a week later Thomas believed

Alleluia. Christ is Risen!

The Lord is Risen indeed!!! Alleluia!!!

When we all need to <u>look toward the altar</u>

Toward the Cross of Jesus Christ ////

Even among a group that had been

With Jesus Christ Himself

It seems that it took a little while

to get things started

How much longer

Will it take to get things started,

With a mere servant of the most high

I often like to anchor a sermon in time

Examine the previous week's readings

See where a reading dwelled in time and place

Ironically, unless I examine a bulletin from last week's

Resurrection Sunday Service

I don't know what you heard regarding

The resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

There are several accounts that you may have heard

Perhaps you heard from Mark ///
Jesus was seen by Mary Magdalene
And those who had been with Jesus
Did not believe her

When she proclaimed the Risen Lord
Or you heard that Jesus appeared to two
Disciples walking about in the country
But the remaining disciples still did not believe.

Maybe you heard from Matthew

Mary Magdalene and the other Mary Went to see the tomb.

AND THERE WAS AN EARTHQUAKE!

And an angel like lightning rolled back the stone and sat on it!

Or perhaps you heard a message from John

Mary Magdalene came to the tomb

And saw that the stone had been removed

So, she told Simon Peter and another

And "Peter, and the other disciple set out

toward the tomb

And they saw the linen wrappings in the tomb

But Mary stayed outside weeping

Before seeing her resurrected Lord."

you may have heard of two disciples

Walking to a village called Emmaus

They asked Jesus to stay with them

(Though they did not know it was him)

And while He was at table;

He took the bread, blessed it, broke it And gave it to them ...

And their eyes were opened ... And He was gone ///

My dilemma in speaking to you this day Is ironic, because, it mirrors The exact problem of the disciples In our Gospel reading today What had they heard? Who had they heard from? What was true? What did they know? Where could they turn???? The women and the disciples had heard a lot They heard it from many different sources None of it sounded like it could possibly be true Given all they knew.... So now they turned to each other

It was evening on that day ... The first day of the week (The first day of REBORN life!) And the doors of the house Where the disciples had met, were locked... For fear of the Jews And Jesus came and stood among them Saying "Peace be with you" And He showed them His hands ... And His Side And they rejoiced And Jesus said again, "Peace be with you," //////// But one was missing, My favorite disciple, Thomas Who doubted, like I, (like we), often do! And Jesus showed Him his scars And even /, believed!

We are, of course a few years removed from this story

OK, perhaps a couple millennia!

So perhaps the various events can be a bit confusing And perhaps we might occasionally be afraid

And that is OK.

Christ's work is revealed slowly

It starts individually, with Mary Magdalene

With a small group of other women

With Peter and another disciple

With another two disciples walking, processing

With the remaining disciples in a locked room

Shaking in fear, locking the door

With one-man Thomas

Who could not believe, unless ...?

He felt Jesus' hands

Felt Jesus' feet

Felt Jesus' side

The first day of reborn life for most Christians Is likely to begin just as slowly The first day of reborn life for a Christian Community Is as likely to begin just as slowly It is likely to begin individually One person at a time One visit, one assurance, One peaceful encounter at a time. And the person who will bring true growth will not be Mary of Magdalene or even Peter It won't be me either The person who will bring true growth Is the Resurrected Jesus

For it is Christ who enters in

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And from Christ's words,
       And from Christ's gentle actions
From Christ's /// Peace /// Among us
   We will feel His presence
   And We will feel compelled
       To proclaim his Gospel /////
And we will proclaim that Gospel
   Not as mere servants,
   (For the servant knows not what the master is doing)
We will proclaim the Good News of Jesus as friends
   Just as His first friends
       His disciples proclaimed that Gospel
We will proclaim despite tyrannical oppression
       From a murderous High Priest
          And his henchmen, Who ....
   GAVE STRICT ORDERS NOT TO TEACH IN HIS NAME
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It was, after all, by showing forth That all the friends of Christ have ever Professed the faith At the beginning of this sermon I proclaimed that today is a day of celebration Yet I continue to proclaim equally loudly That TODAY IS NOT A DAY OF CELEBRATION Because this congregation has seen Its new hope in a mere servant of Christ Today is NOT a day of celebration because Some earthly herald or prophet Or even in some angel! Has proclaimed it so

Today is a day of celebration

Because we, even like Thomas,

Have seen that:

GOD IS NOT DEAD!

GOD IS TRULY ALIVE!

And we have been assured of that by Jesus himself

Each of us, in our own lives

In our own stories

In Jesus' own way!

Yet if we have not seen that truth

The truth of Christ's bodily resurrection

from the dead

If we have doubts,

We have more Good News!

Jesus not only died for us and lives for us

But if we just admit to him and to each other

That we have doubts;

Jesus, through His Holy Spirit,

Will enter our lives

Our Triune God will

Enter our discussions

He will walk us through His crucifixion,

Giving us the Holy Spirit

HE, will forgive us our sins ///

If we ask HIM to stay with us

At His table; He will take the bread,

Bless it, Brake it; And give it to us ...

So our eyes may be opened ...

Today is a day of celebration For the Christian Church For this parish And for this City of Vickburg For on this Sunday in the Season of Easter God Himself has spoken. This is a day of celebration! And it has served as such Since the time of Jesus Himself; This day in the city of Vicksburg (To paraphrase another preacher,) This day, there is another voice to be heard Another claim for human life //// Let the forces of evil be forever on notice! ////

God has not abandoned the poor

God has not abandoned the stranger God has not abandoned the Lonely, The captive, the desperate God has not abandoned any of us, To be victimized By those who traffic in greed and power God has entered this world Been crucified by it Yet overcame it And to all those who try to say, WE GAVE YOU STRICT ORDERS NOT TO TEACH IN JESUS NAME, Let them be on notice, that we The disciples the One Lord, Jesus Christ "We must obey God Rather than any human authority!"

Today mark a new dawn for the Church of the Holy Trinity

Yet any such concern is quickly dissipated
